The Ice Show, which is our grand finale, will take place on **SUNDAY, APRIL 1st, 2012. (Tentative Time 4:30 p.m.) Rehearsal scheduled for Saturday, March 31st, 2012. (2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.). For those of you who have not had your child enrolled in our skating program before, this event is a fun filled afternoon where all of our children from pre-can and up get an opportunity to showcase their skills to their family and friends.

This year, our canskaters will perform to music from the movies of 2011/2012. As we have had very positive response over the past several years with hiring seamstresses to create the costumes for our skaters, we have decided to pursue this route again this year. Advance payment and an early start to preparations will certainly make for a well-organized show and your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
